If you mail artwork or skeins, please hand write "Mail-in Entry" on all forms.** Prepaid return postage and address labels must accompany the mailed-in packages. Any work that is mailed in an envelope must contain the correct size, new postage paid, return mailing envelope with return address labels and postage attached. (Remember to leave enough room in your return envelopes and boxes for possible ribbons!) If you wish your returned artwork to be insured by United Parcel Service, proper prepaid labels must accompany the work.
